Re: Warning of court action due to failure to provide an express confirmatory decision

Our clients: Public.Resource.Org Inc and Right to Know CLG

Dear Sir or Madam

We refer to our clients' application for access to documents filed on 4 June 2024. We also refer to the Commission's proposal for a fair solution received on 16 July 2024, one day before the time limit for the Commission's response. On 23 July 2024 our clients sought a confirmatory application which included a detailed response to the fair solution proposal through which the Commission could provide access to the requested documents in full without imposing an undue burden.

On 14 August 2024 the Commission extended the deadline for a reply to the confirmatory application to 6 September 2024. The Commission has not met this deadline, nor has it provided any further communication or update in relation to the confirmatory application. Although it made proposals for a fair solution and imposed a five-day deadline for a response, the Commission has not reciprocated by replying to the detailed response from our clients and their counter proposal.

In the confirmatory application our clients set out the importance of granting access to documents based on the principles of the rule of law and of openness and made a proposal through which the Commission could grant full access to all of the documents according to an agreed timetable.

As the Commission is aware Article 8(3) of Regulation 1049/2001 provides that failure by the institution to reply within the prescribed time limit shall be considered as a negative reply and entitle the applicant to institute court proceedings against the institution. Nonetheless, the Court of Justice has held, that even in such a case where the institution fails to reply within the prescribe time limit, it still retains the power to make an express decision even after the deadline has passed<sup>1</sup>.
