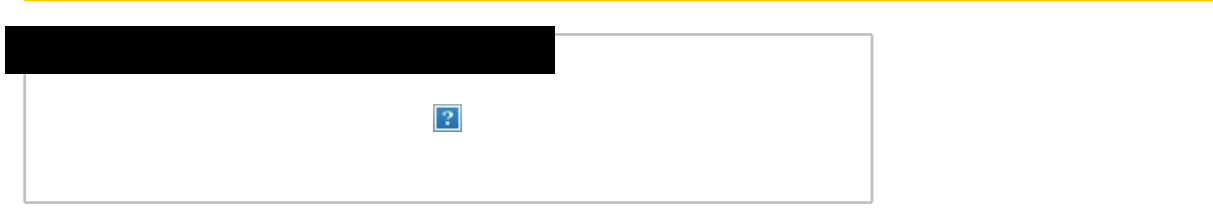
We are just finishing the tweaks but please see the attached document with our comments included.

As per your two points raised.

The service has Analytics and Trends for Admins that can report on page views/content usage and user profiles – if you can provide a list of the exact reporting requirements that will help. Most reports can be exported as .csv file by Admins from the service. You can view this if you Log-in with your same Intertek password in the Admin area under your profile picture and click on KPI reports.

Your point 2 'sponsored access' – additional related documents can be loaded into the service of course but is that what you mean? Sponsored sounds like paid for somehow? That is very different and beyond this simple scope. So more information needed probably.
