Following a recent communication, it is likely that the launch date required will now be 27th June. I will confirm this as soon as we receive a formal communication to proceed.

I'm aware that Gavin is working to resolve the SSL certificate issue, which must now be resolved tomorrow to support external stakeholder access.

I sincerely apologise for the inconvenience of the changing timelines, which are unfortunately beyond NSAI's control. NSAI has committed to hosting the national portal and abiding by the requirements and instruction of the European Commission and CEN CENELEC. NSAI's link is included on the central Europe redirection page and must be operational on the agreed launch date. So, we'll need to remain in contact tomorrow to complete the preparations.
