Dear Mr. Malamud:

This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act request dated May 20, 2009, received in my office on May 28, 2009.

You requested an estimate of the amount of money that the Comptroller of the Currency (OCC) spends on matters regarding access the PACER system and related budget issues

Please be advised the OCC uses PACER very little. We have a few accounts established via the standard PACER online subscription service. We do not separately budget for PACER since we expect very few expenses. Instead, we provide for funding via miscellaneous budget accounts.

We do not have any history on expenses back to 2000. For the fiscal year 2009, expenses for PACER totaled \$1,8204. We estimate \$1,000 for FY 2010.

The attached list shows the costs from Westlaw and LexisNexis since FY2002.

The totals for West Publishing from December 2001 to October 6, 2008 are \$2,838,916.95. The totals for Reed Elsevier Inc., from December 2001 to December 2008 are \$1,416.053.72.
