CHANGE OF VENUE IN CIVIL ACTIONS.

This cause had been transferred from Washington to this county, under the act of congress of June 24, 1812, § 8 (2 Stat 755), at the last term.

Coxe, for defendant, moved for a rule on the plaintiff to show cause, on the first day of the next term at Washington, why the order for transferring this cause from Washington to this county should not be rescinded; it not having been made upon such affidavits as are required by the rule of court made in May term, 1821, at Alexandria.
