Circuit Court, District of Columbia. Nov. Term, 1837.

WITNESS-NEGRO-MULATTO BORN OF WHITE WOMAN.

Indictment for larceny. The defendant was a colored man, horn of a white woman.

THE COURT rejected, as witnesses, free colored persons, not born of white mothers.

Verdict, not guilty.
