## SET OFF-DEBT DUE ONE DEFENDANT.

Debt upon a sealed bill. Plea, payment, and an account in bar.

The defendants [J. R. Bussard and Daniel Bussard] offered to set off an account of J.

R. Bussard against the plaintiff for medical services.

Mr. Caldwell, for plaintiff.

H. H. Chapman, for defendants.

THE COURT (CRANCH, Chief Judge, doubting) refused to allow the account to be given in evidence.
