## Comment

I would like to ask the committee to re-consider the sections of WCAG 2.0 relating to text enlargement for low vision users. Text enlargement of up to 200% may be insufficient for readability for some low vision users. In the past year, I have been conducting research on the readability of text as a function of magnification and magnification with word-wrapping. Without word-wrapping, enlargements of 200% or more resulted in the need for users to scroll horizontally to view the material. Horizontal scrolling is not recommended in terms of usability and could decrease user performance on some tasks. As a result, please reconsider the low vision requirements for WCAG 2.0 to address this issue.
