For example, many institutions prefer and/or accept only online submissions of job applications thus putting many individuals with disabilities at a grave disadvantage when seeking employment. Videos should be captioned and all documents posted online should be accessible to screen readers so that individuals with vision problems can experience equal opportunity with regards to access to information.

It is also of paramount importance that vendors and manufacturers of equipment, telephone systems, and point of sale systems truly be accessible to individuals with disabilities. This is especially important for individuals with blindness and point of sale equipment. There should be a way to enlarge the information presented on the screen and the system should be adaptable to accessible keyboards.
