RE: Petition for Rulemaking (Docket No. PHMSA-2010-0009)

Dear Messrs. Bates and Kawasuso:

In a letter to the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) dated February 14, 2012, you submitted a petition for rulemaking to amend the Federal Pipeline Safety Regulations (PSR) (49 CFR Parts 190-199). A public docket for the petition has been established at <u>www.regulations.gov</u> in Docket No. PHMSA-2010-0009.

The petition requests PHMSA to amend §§ 192.121 and 192.123 to allow the use of Polyamide 12 (PA12) piping systems; include maximum design pressure limitations for PA12 piping systems; and incorporate by reference ASTM International (ASTM) standards pertaining to PA12 Pipe and Components.

In accordance with the petition processing requirements in § 190.333, PHMSA is granting your petition for rulemaking. A grant is a determination made by PHMSA that the petition contains adequate justification to initiate a rulemaking action to consider its incorporation into the PSR. As specified in § 190.333(b), PHMSA has initiated a rulemaking that will address your petition. The regulatory identification number for the rulemaking is 2137-AE93. Please note that a grant of a petition does not guarantee that the petition will be incorporated into the PSR as proposed.
