SUMMARY OF MEETING:

The work group met and revised several of the proposed requirements for the voluntary safety standard. Nuisance tripping requirements were pulled out from other tests and will be addressed in a separate section. Temperature and humidity tests were added to the switch requirements. Additionally, two methods of stalled motor tests were developed.

The work group will work on requirements for separate nuisance tripping tests, strain relief tests, and the stalled motor tests for the next meeting in March.
