SUMMARY OF MEETING:

The meeting convened at 10:30 AM. The meeting was requested by CYBIAG. Tom Lyons (CYBIAG) provided an overview of the company and its product. CYBIAG manufactures a garage door system that is targeted for upscale custom-built residences. The system consists of the garage door frame and garage door operator. The exterior of the door is finished with the same material as the remainder of the house including brick or stone. Windows and pedestrian doors can be installed in the CYBIAG garage door. The product will be sold through a system of authorized installers/dealers. Safety features include an inherent reversing system as well as two infrared electric eyes and an edge sensing device. Don Grob (UL) indicated that CYBIAG has raised alternative methods of meeting the intent of UL 325 that will result in some changes to the entrapment protection requirements of UL 325. The meeting adjourned at 11:30.
