Thanks for the heads up. We are up in NYC at the ASTM Board meeting. I have had the chance to discuss your email with 3 government reps, none of which could make it to ACUS on Friday. But I am still working on it. Did you contact Jim Turner?

On the substance of the ARL and EFF comments, I am considering submitting a letter from ASTM that references the fact that SDO community just completed an 18 month effort of working with the NSTC SOS that culminated in the Oct 13 report that essentially concluded the government and regulated community benefit from SIBR and that it is entirely appropriate for SDOs to receive monetary compensation to ensure the continued vibrancy of their work.
