Target Area Contract Preference Act (TACPA)

STD. 830G (NEW 8-93)

CONTRACTS FOR GOODS (Use 830S for Contracts for Services)

The Target Area Contract Preference Act (Government Code Section 4530, et seq.) and the regulations (Section 1896, et seq. Title 2 of the California Code of Regulations) implementing the Act, may provide up to a five (5) percent preference to the California based companies which certify, under penalty of perjury, that for contracts for goods (Government Code Section 4533 - purchase equipment, materials, or supplies) no less than 50 percent of the labor required to perform the contract shall be accomplished at a worksite or worksites located in a distressed area. Construction contracts are excluded under this Act.

Additional preferences ranging from 1 to 4 percent are provided if a qualified bidder agrees that persons with high risk of unemployment, as defined, will be hired to perform the contract. **Note that no preferences may be granted unless the lowest responsible bid or proposal submitted is in excess of \$100,000.**

SECTION A

TACPA 5% DISTRESSED WORKSITE PREFERENCE

This Invitation For Bids or Request For Proposals shall fall within the provisions of the Employment and Economic Incentive Act if the lowest responsible bid exceeds \$100,000. If you are interested in this preference, there are six ways your firm can qualify. By checking any one of the three boxes below, the bidder agrees that no less than 50% of the labor required to perform the contract shall be accomplished at a designated enterprise zone. **Failure to check the applicable preference below will disqualify the bidder's eligibility for the worksite preference.**

The bidder must certify, under penalty of perjury, that no less than 50% of the workforce of the contract will be performed in the distressed area. A bidder proposing to use such a producer or supplier may satisfy the 50% labor requirement by a combination of both the bidder and selected producer or supplier performing the contract work in that distressed area. | <input type="checkbox"/> Your firm may arrange to use a manufacturer or supplier located in directly adjoining census tract blocks that when attached to the distressed area forms a contiguous boundary. Note: That "50 percent of the labor required" means that one-half the total employee hours needed to perform the contract involved. In computing total employee hours with respect to a contract for goods, the employee hours required for manufacturing the goods offered shall be included regardless of whether a bidder is, or is not the manufacturer of the goods.

Definition: The submitted map must indicate the bid or proposal; the location of the proposed worksite; clearly delineate the census tract block in which the worksite is located and the adjoining census tract block group which may qualify pursuant to Section 4532(d).

WORKSITE(S) IDENTIFICATION: Bidders proposing to perform the contract at a distressed worksite or worksites are required to identify such site or sites in the space provided below. Failure to identify a site or sites which qualifies as a distressed area site(s) will result in disallowance of the requested preference.

TACPA DISTRESSED WORK FORCE PREFERENCE

Bidders must qualify for the worksite preference prior to requesting any work force preference. Bidders requesting the hiring preference must check one applicable preference below. **Failure to check the applicable preference below will disqualify the bidder's eligibility for the work force preference.**

| <input type="checkbox"/> A 1-percent preference if the bidder agrees to hire persons with a high risk of unemployment at a rate equal to 5 to 9 percent of the work force during the period of contract performance. | <input type="checkbox"/> A 3-percent preference if the bidder agrees to hire persons with a high risk of unemployment at a rate equal to 15 to 19 percent of the work force during the period of contract performance. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> A 2-percent preference if the bidder agrees to hire persons with a high risk of unemployment at a rate equal to 10 to 14 percent of the work force during the period of contract performance. | <input type="checkbox"/> A 4-percent preference if the bidder agrees to hire persons with a high risk of unemployment at a rate equal to 20 percent or more of the work force during the period of contract performance. |

TACPA DISTRESSED WORKSITE IDENTIFICATION CERTIFICATION

In order to receive the TACPA preference(s) the following certification must be completed and signed:

I hereby certify under penalty of perjury, that the bidder is a California-based company, as defined in the regulations, and that no less than 50% of the labor required to perform the contract shall be accomplished at a worksite or worksites located in a designated enterprise zone. Furthermore, when the work force preference is claimed, it will be in compliance with the provisions of the Act. Any person willfully providing false information is subject to serious penalties.
