1. Please drop the word 'Part' down on 8 and 10 (otherwise the numbers are hanging on the next line); **For some reason this doesn't affect my screen for Part 8 – this may be a screen resolution issue?**
2. Please place Part 9 before 11 on the bookshelf; **Agreed!**
3. Can you clarify what the Errata binder (last code book) indicates? Is it a one stop source for all 2013 (Emergency) Supplements and Errata? If so, we'd like to clarify that in the text, which I can draft. **Yes, I believe ICC previously posted all supplements and errata for the current and previous edition (by state), under the main heading "Errata Central"**
4. It appears that these versions are downloadable and may be saved. Is that correct or is it just because it's not live? **I was able to download them as well, although printing is still prohibited.**
