ASHRAE cannot advocate the adoption or use of Standard 189.1 in the United States independent of the IGCC.

If we know someone is proposing to reference just 189.1, we are obligated to propose a reference to the IGCC which contains the 189.1 compliance option.

That being said, we can't force a jurisdiction to choose what to reference. If we ask them to reference the IGCC, and they say no, then that's the only way just the adoption of 189.1 can occur.
