Or, students could try and do some term papers on the general topic (I'm more than happy to help, there are some other folks like Peter Martin they could interact with .... it's actually a nice offer for a couple of bright students who might want to reach out).

Let's figure out how to salvage this thing ... I think there is great promise when a state legislator, even a very junior minority party legislator, is willing to lend credence to an analysis of why policy is perhaps broken. Students get to put that they did some important work commissioned by the legislature on their resume as well. I don't care how long it takes, I'm more interested in seeing that the work somehow get underway.
