10. **PROGRAM:** A "Round Table" discussion moderated by the REACO President. In attendance will be Carl Malamud from Public.Resource.Org and representatives from ICC. Public.Resource.Org publishes regulatory documents including building codes for public access. ICC publishes the International Codes that are amended by the State of California. The California Building Standards Commission publishes the California Code of Regulations, Title 24, which are enforced by local jurisdictions in California. The topic is public access to building codes and how this impacts ICC and the public in general. The topic was extensively discussed at the March REACO meeting. The Redwood Empire Association of Code Officials does not officially support the Public.Resource.Org's position. It is important, however, for the public to hear the issues associated with public access for government regulatory codes.
